Some time ago the Town purchased air source heat pumps which reflects the Town's pursuit of environmentally sound means of heating and cooling the town office building.

Air source heat pumps extract heat from the air outside and distribute it inside a building. During warmer months, the process is reversed to provide cooling by pulling heat out of the building.

This model is known as a ductless mini-split system and consists of an outdoor compressor or condenser unit that connects to an indoor unit to distribute heat or cool the office building.

The CSC Task Force is continuously looking for ways to reduce greenhouse gas emissions and welcomes input and recommendations from town residents.
